The Explorer Belt is a very different type of expedition, to explore an unknown country for 10 days in small teams. The award is very rare, with around only 50 being presented each year, across the UK. When you have completed the award, you gain a special Belt!



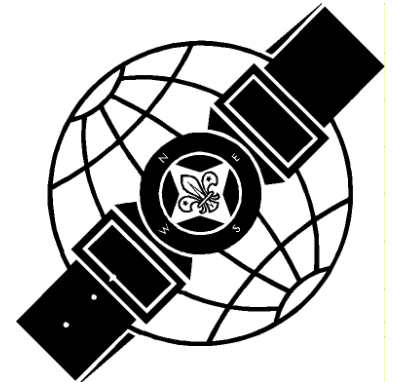
Where are we going to?

Well, we don't know! That's down to you. Once we have all of the applications in, you will decide. We will be looking at a European country, one that nobody in the teams has spent any reasonable amount of time in. Assuming that we have several countries that we can consider, you will then decide, after doing some research.

When and how much is it?

Whilst the exploring is for 10 days, the trip will take 14-16 days. We plan to leave on Saturday 30th June 18, and return by Sunday 15th July 18.

The cost is likely to be around £500—£700, much will of course depend on the country chosen. We can not confirm the cost until April 18.
