There is car parking in front of the United Reformed Church. There is overflow parking at St Boniface Church, on Hursley Road, about five minutes walk from the Scout hall

Refreshments for the Cubs and their leaders. The hall is five minutes walk from Fryern Arcade shopping centre.

Rules

- Each District may enter one team of up to six cubs.
- Cubs to be in top half uniform including neckers.
- Each team should book in on arrival by handing in the attached form and £15 entry fee with the District name, the name of each team member and emergency contact details (if a leader is not staying).
- A leader/adult from each district should accompany each team and will be required to support the event.
- Each team should bring a contribution to the Scrapheap (see overleaf)
- Teams will be judged on teamwork, construction and artistic merit.
 - The two halls (Scout hall and Church hall) will be judged separately. The top two teams in each hall will then be moderated to determine the overall winners.
- Refreshments, tables, chairs will be supplied, along with paint, glue, brushes.

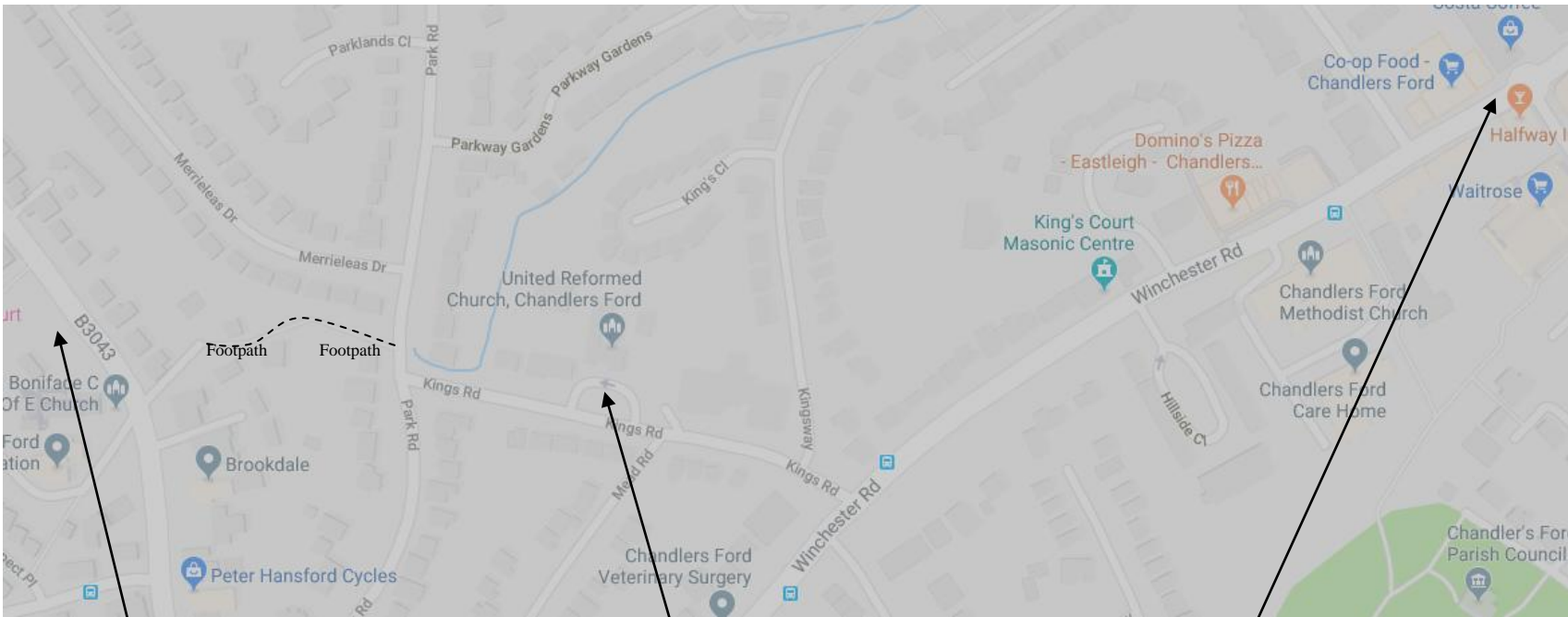

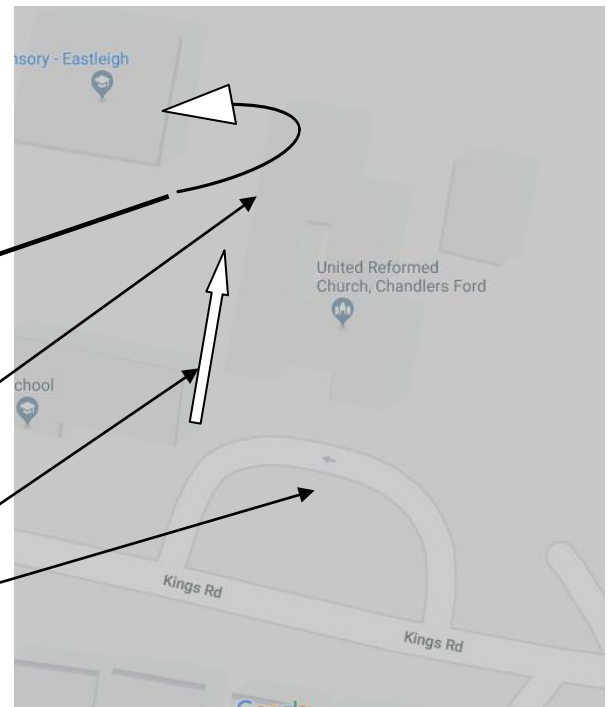
